Talk Summary

Dr. I.P. Dhakal will share his thoughts on changing roles of higher education in agriculture of Nepal in the context of sustainable agricultural and forestry development from teaching, research, and extension perspectives. He will share his vision for the future of the AFU that has already produced thousands of mid and high level agricultural manpower serving nationally and internationally, major challenges of his times and his vision on how AFU should work on meeting these emerging challenges of the 21st century.

Speaker: Dr. I. P. Dhakal, a Professor of Veterinary

Medicine is the Vice Chancellor of Agriculture and Forestry University, Nepal. He was born at Harmi Bhanjyang of Gorkha District. He completed MSc in Veterinary Medicine from Haryana Agriculture University, India and Ph.D. in Veterinary Medicine from Rakuno Gakuen University, Japan. He worked as Campus Chief in Rampur Campus, Tribhuvan University from 2008- 2012 and is the first Director of Veterinary Teaching Hospital, Rampur. He was the first Dean of Faculty of Animal Science, Veterinary Science and Fisheries at AFU during 2012-2015. He took the leadership on Nepal Veterinary Association as well as Nepal Veterinary Council as the Vice President. He is the Vice Chairman of One Health Alliance Nepal. Professionally, his specialization is on buffalo mastitis and milk quality. His research interests are Zoonotic, foodborne and vector borne diseases having public health impacts. He is the Past President of Rotary Club of Bharatpur , Rotary International District 3292 Nepal-Bhutan. Dr. Dhakal has 36 years of excellent track record in teaching, research, and community development.
